Preface

East London Soccer Club believes soccer should be a fun and personally rewarding experience. This Code of Conduct is written to improve our programs and our athletes. This Code of Conduct applies to all parents/guardians and spectators.

I understand as a parent/guardian and spectator that I must act in accordance with the following code:

Respect and Responsibility

1. Treat all people with respect all the time and require the same of youth-athletes.
2. Be gracious in victory; accept defeat with dignity; give fallen opponents a hand; compliment performance.
3. Don't engage in trash-talking, taunting, boastful celebrations, or actions that demean individuals or the sport.
4. Treat officials with respect; don't argue with calls or decisions during or after an athletic event.
5. Don't engage in profanity, verbal abuse, disrespectful conduct or obscene gestures during sporting events.
6. Make the experience enjoyable, increase self-esteem and be realistic in goals and expectations.
7. Encourage youth-athletes to think and play as a team, discourage selfishness.
8. Discuss the importance of character, ethics, and sportsmanship with the youth-athlete.
9. Maintain a thorough knowledge of current game and competition rules, ensuring youth-athletes know and understand the rules.
10. Control my ego and emotions; avoid displays of anger and frustration; don't retaliate.
11. Strive to provide a challenging, safe, enjoyable, and successful experience for the youth-athlete by maintaining a sports environment that is physically and emotionally safe.

ELSC Sanctions Policy

(All divisions)

Parents

- If a parent is disruptive from the sidelines, the referee will approach the parent and attempt to resolve the issue.
- If the issue persists or worsens, the referee will ask the coach and/or convenor to address the issue with the parent.
- If these actions are unsuccessful, the game will be called and the team will take a loss.
- The referee will record it on their game sheet and log it via email to the referee scheduler.
- Smoking tobacco products is illegal on/around publicly owned outdoor sporting areas, spectator areas, sporting areas and public areas within 20 metres of any point of the edge of the sporting or spectator areas.
- The minimum fine for smoking in a prohibited area is \$250. Tobacco Enforcement Officers conduct inspections and respond to complaints regarding non-compliance and issue fines as necessary.

Violations of the Parent Code of Conduct may result in:

1. Disciplinary review.
2. Banishment from the fields.
3. Removal from East London Soccer Club.
